Spaces will be available to exhibit from January to March 2010 (winter term). Depending on the number of submissions received, exhibitions will run either weekly or biweekly (at the discretion of the curator). Artists should apply with the assumption that they may be exhibiting as early as January 2010 and will need to have all work completed for that date.

Please complete this form and submit it along with the following items:

1. Photo documentation of your work, all work you wish to exhibit must be represented.

This can be submitted in the form of photographs of the work (no larger than 8.5" x 11"), or digital images on a CD (please save images in .jpg format). Please do not submit slides unless absolutely necessary.

2. An artists statement.

This should be no longer than approximately one typed page, double-spaced. Please describe the main crux of your work as a whole, and more specifically the work you intend to exhibit should your application be selected for and exhibition.

All Applications should be dropped off in room 335 of the Student Centre. A box will be made available for collecting the applications; if you cannot locate it, ask one of the office employees, and they will be more than happy you help you locate it.

A Note on Group exhibitions:

If you are applying for a show with another person or multiple people, each artist will be required to fill out their own application and submit their own work; however, the applications may be submitted in one large envelope to ensure the work stays together. The curator reserves the right to accept one portion of a group application and not others. The curator also reserves the right to create group exhibitions from the applications that demonstrate strong talent but have few pieces ready for exhibition.
